



















# Toronto/Niagara Falls

<p><b><u>Niagara Falls</u></b></p>		
<p><b>Journey Behind the Falls</b></p>	<p>The sound is like thunder, the sight awe-inspiring! Take a journey deep below and behind the heart of Niagara and stand in the mist where the mighty Horseshoe Falls tumbles from 13 stories above! Every second during summer daylight hours, over 2,800 cubic meters of water thunders over the rim at 65 kilometers per hour.</p>	
<p><b>Maid of the Mist</b></p>	<p>Water rushes all around as you "soak" in the excitement and explore the roar of the Falls. A historical ride aboard the world-famous Maid of the Mist is a half hour thrill of a lifetime! North America's oldest tourist attraction, millions of visitors have enjoyed the boat tours since 1846.</p>	
<p><b>Illuminations of the Falls</b></p>	<p>Every evening beginning at dusk the Falls are lit in the colors of the rainbow - don't miss the unmatched beauty of the Falls at night!</p>	
<p><b>Butterfly Conservatory</b></p>	<p>This magical attraction features over 2,000 colorful tropical butterflies floating freely among lush, exotic blossoms and greenery. Paths wind through the rainforest setting, past a pond and waterfall and the Emergence window, where butterflies leave their pupae and prepare to take their first flight!</p>	
<p><b>Clifton Hills</b></p>	<p>Clifton Hill is the major tourist promenade in Niagara Falls, Ontario. The street contains a number of gift shops, wax museums, haunted houses, restaurants, hotels and themed attractions. For visitors, particularly families and teenagers, it is a major amusement area and centre for night life.</p>	
<p><b>Skylon Tower</b></p>	<p>Skylon Tower is Niagara's tallest total entertainment complex. It includes indoor/outdoor observation of the Falls from 233 meters (775'), Two great dining rooms both overlooking the Falls. At the base, Niagara's largest indoor amusement area, Skylon Fun Centre, complete with a food court and 4D Theatre. Shop in one of our 12 specialty shops on the main level as a prelude to your Ride to the Top in our glass enclosed Yellow Bug elevators.</p>	
<p><b>White Water Walk</b></p>	<p>Stroll along a boardwalk at the very edge of one of the world's wildest stretches of whitewater! Marvel at the relentless power and beauty of nature and see how the deep and narrow Great Gorge was created. Trillions of gallons of water are forced into this accelerating trough - the sight will take your breath away!</p>

<p><b>CN Tower</b></p>	<p>CN Tower, the world's Tallest Building and Wonder of the Modern World, offers spectacular views, spell-binding Glass Floor, motion theatre ride, arcade and fantastic shopping. Defining the Toronto skyline, the CN Tower is Canada's most recognizable and celebrated icon. At a height of 553.33m (1,815 ft., 5 inches), it is Canada's National Tower, the World's Tallest Building, an important telecommunications hub, and the centre of tourism in Toronto.</p>	
<p><b>Eaton Centre</b></p>	<p>Toronto Eaton Centre is one of the city's legendary landmarks and the #1 retail destination in Toronto. Located in the heart of downtown with over 250 shops, services and restaurants.</p>
